

LHS Softball Settles for Senior Day Split

It wasn't a great week for the Liberal softball team. After blowout losses (24-5 and 12-1) to Garden City Tuesday, Liberal split with a 1-7 Wichita Southeast team Friday on Senior Day at the Liberal Softball Complex. LHS won the first game 11-9 but lost game two 10-6.

In game one, LHS won despite seven errors. LHS scored one in the first and five in the second to take a 6-0 lead before Southeast put up a four spot in the third. Liberal scored in the third to lead 7-4. LHS took an 8-4 lead with a run in the fourth. Southeast plated two in the fifth and three in the fifth.
