The national average for the census participation rate as of April 7th was 62%. The average for the state of Kansas was 67%. The counties in Kansas with the highest rates range from Northeast Kansas to Southcentral Kansas. They are:

Nemaha County - 77%

Marshall County - 76%

Saline County - 76%

Pratt County - 74%

The counties with the lowest participation rates are all in Southwest Kansas. They are:

Hamilton County - 42%

Morton County - 45%

Seward County - 48%

Stanton County - 50%
