The rich history of the Native American culture is well represented in the artwork which depicts historic events and everyday life through paintings, drawings, and bronze sculptures.

The artifacts include Navaho rugs, baskets, cradle boards, moccasins, dresses, war shirt, head dress, jewelry, Kachinas, photographs, buffalo hide, and many other items.

Viewing this exhibit is a wonderful educational experience and will enhance the understanding and appreciation of the rich heritage that it represents.

There will be an Opening Reception August 24th from 2:00 to 5:00 pm at the center located at 624 N. Pershing in Liberal. The exhibit will be on display now through October 5, 2013.

The lower level gallery will feature select Native American Art and Artifact items from the Permanent Collection to compliment the current exhibit in the main galleries.
